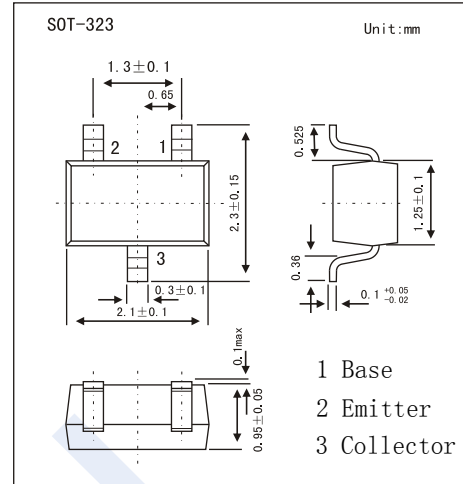


NPN Transistors

2SC4116

■ Features

- High voltage and high current
- High h_{FE} : $h_{FE} = 70\sim 700$
- Low noise: $NF = 1\text{dB (typ.)}$, 10dB (max)
- Small package
- Complementary to 2SA1586
