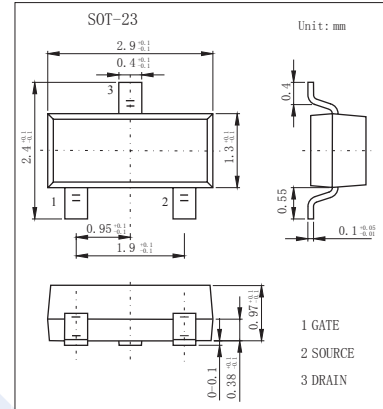
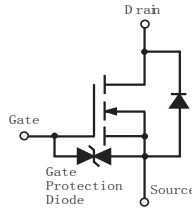

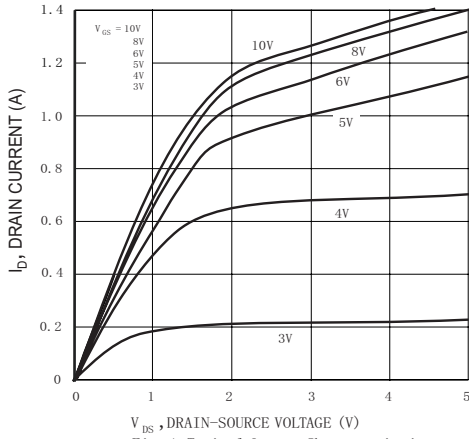


Fig. 1 Typical Output Characteristics

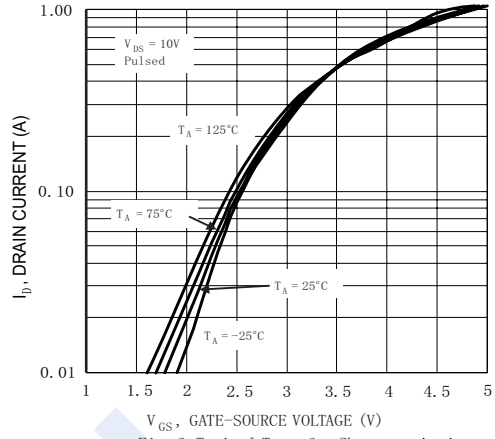


Fig. 2 Typical Transfer Characteristics

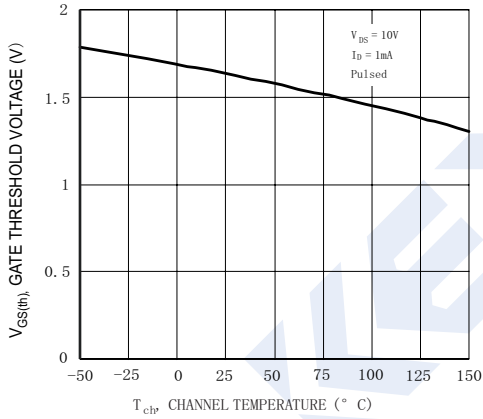


Fig. 3 Gate Threshold Voltage vs. Channel Temperature

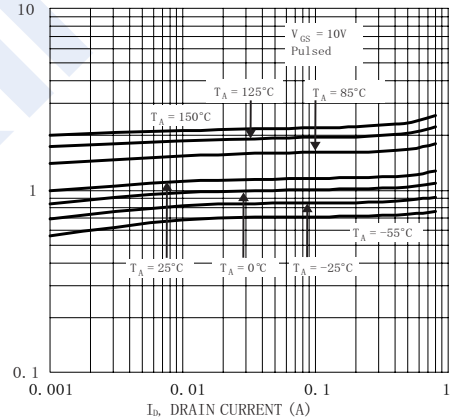


Fig. 4 Static Drain-Source On-Resistance vs. Drain Current

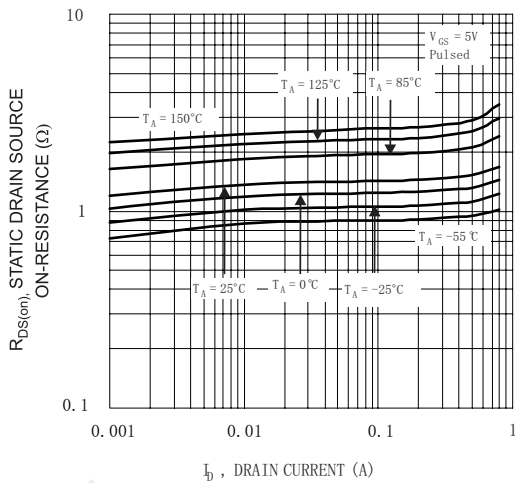


Fig. 5 Static Drain-Source On-Resistance vs. Drain Current

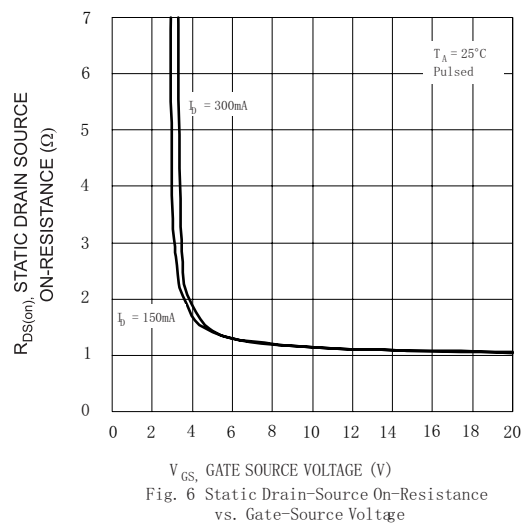


Fig. 6 Static Drain-Source On-Resistance vs. Gate-Source Voltage

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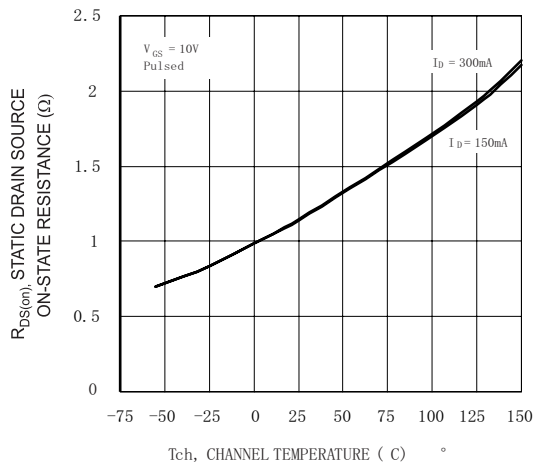


Fig. 7 Static Drain-Source On-State Resistance vs. Channel Temperature

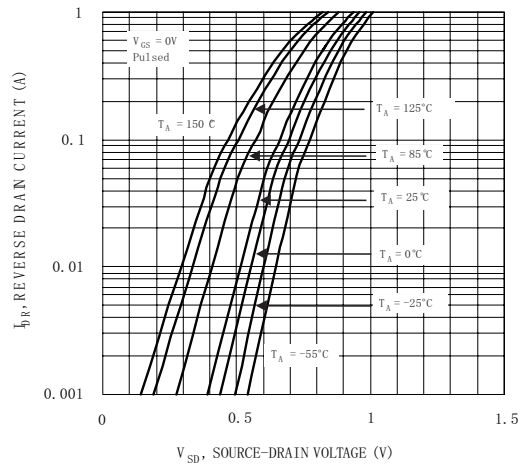


Fig. 8 Reverse Drain Current vs. Source-Drain Voltage

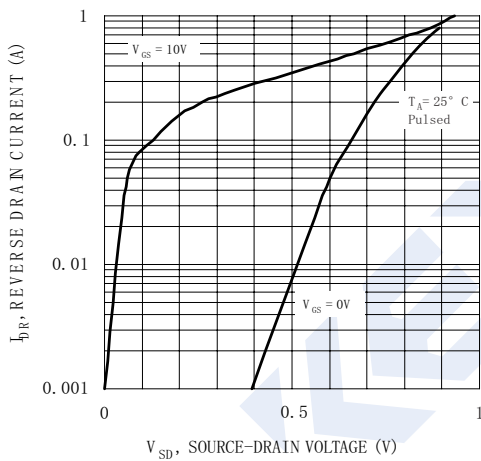


Fig. 9 Reverse Drain Current vs. Source-Drain Voltage

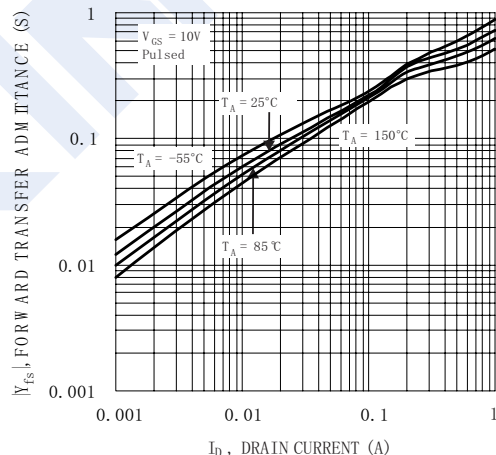


Fig. 10 Forward Transfer Admittance vs. Drain Current
